Patricia W. Edwards Memorial Art Scholarship

The Patricia W. Edwards Memorial Art Fund was established 20 years ago to further the education of Rhode Island high school students studying painting and/or drawing. Awards will be given to students to take art lessons in two-dimensional art at Rhode Island nonprofit institutions (e.g., Rhode Island School of Design's Young Artist Program, AS220, etc.):

SELECTION CRITERIA

In order to qualify as an applicant, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a high school freshman, sophomore or junior in Rhode Island.
- Able to demonstrate artistic ability and interest in art studies.

A COMPLETE APPLICATION INCLUDES:

- A completed application form, which includes a recommendation by the student's art teacher or guidance counselor.
- A paragraph written by the student explaining why he/she wants to take the art course and why he/she feels qualified to receive the scholarship.
- Three to five original two-dimensional artworks (no ceramics) representative of the student's work (size not to exceed 18" x 24"). All artwork must be clearly labeled with name and school, dropped off at the Foundation and then collected upon notification.

DEADLINE

Your application must arrive by **April 15, 2009**.
